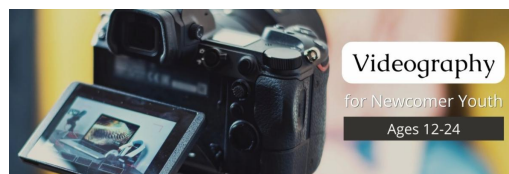
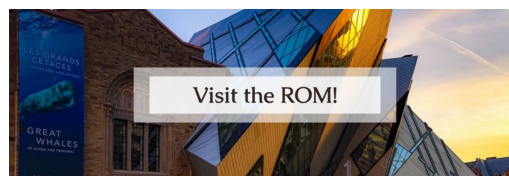


CultureLink's Bike Host program is back for a 2022 season!
